Please do enjoy tonight's procession and if you are able to, please dig deep and support your town with donations to keep this show on the road.

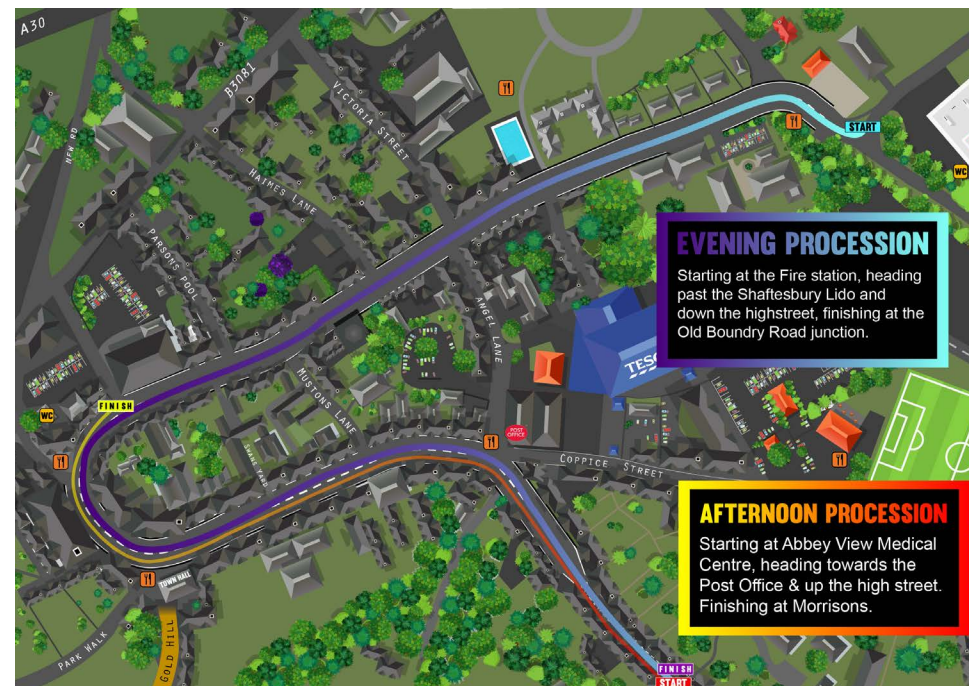
