BARTON HILL ADVENTURE PLAY AREA

As you are probably aware the above scheme was proposed last year to provide a much needed play facility for the Town.

During the past year we have submitted plans to the North Dorset District Council, which were approved subject to certain ammendments and we are now in the process of confirming details with Shaftesbury Town Council. When we receive the final go-ahead we will aim to start the project next Spring. The scheme includes an Adventure Play Area, Under 7's and over 7's Play Areas, a Boating Pond, Paddling Pool and Cycle Track.

There are now many safety standards required to build such a play area and the costs involved will be high, but this need not be a deterrent.

The Carnival Committee has kindly agreed to make us a donation from this year's Carnival funds. Please give as generously as you can to help us make a "dream come true" for the Children of Shaftesbury.
